e-Learning support for an integrated coastal zone management

Integrated coastal zone management (ICZM) is a strategy for future-oriented planning and development in marine and coastal areas. ICZM respects and therefore integrates various interests in planning processes, for example, nature conservation, tourism, coastal protection, and fisheries, as well as local besides regional interests.

For the successful integration of such diverse interests, all participants in an ICZM process need a common knowledge base for coastal topics. The online learning system "IKZM-D Lernen" offers an opportunity for that. Furthermore, the EUCC-D website provides a number of databases for the exchange of project data, documents, photos and the like.
